

# Internal Recognition and Recommendation Scheme (IRRS) for NUS Psychology Society – 2019/20

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## **RAS and IRRS**

Under the Residence Admission Scheme (RAS), societies and interest groups qualified as “Active” by the Office of Student Affairs (OSA) can nominate their members for priority in hostel allocation. Priority will be given during the hostel application for AY20/21. The following IRRS will be used to determine which NUS Psychology Society Executive Committee members or which NUS Psychology Society members are eligible to submit their names for priority housing allocation.

### **Category A – Executive and Management Committee of Student Groups (4 recommendations for non-guaranteed places)**

The President reserves the right to deny any applicant found unfit for the scheme under this category even in the event of excess slots (or the Vice-President only, if the applicant is the President). The denied applicant must be informed of the reason.

#### *Scenario 1: More than 4 applicants*

A vote will be conducted within the Executive Committee. All tied applicants are expected to send a short write-up (no more than 300 words) justifying their suitability and reasons for wanting the scheme. The Executive Committee will then cast their votes (each person must vote and is allowed to vote for as many candidates as they want, including voting for themselves).

In the event of a tie, the President will determine the most suitable applicant. In the event the President is one of the tied applicants, the person determining the most suitable applicant will be the Vice-President, followed by the Honorary General Secretary (should the Vice-President also be one of the tied applicants), Assistant Honorary General Secretary (should the above 3 all be tied applicants), Honorary Treasurer (should the above 4 all be tied applicants).

#### *Scenario 2: Less than or equal to 4 applicants*

No other procedures are necessary. The President will facilitate the process.

### **Category D – Members of Student Groups (10 recommendations for non-guaranteed places)**

The Executive Committee reserves the right to deny any applicant found unfit for the scheme under this category even in the event of excess slots. The denied applicant must be informed of the reason.

#### *Scenario 1: More than 10 applicants*

Anyone interested must be a member in the Society and have contributed to the society in one way or another in AY2018/19 or AY2019/20 (described below). Priority for applicants is as follows.

<b>Priority Level</b>	<b>(Highest) Position Held</b>
1 (Highest)	Executive Committee in the previous Academic Year
2	Project Director/Assistant Project Director for major projects in the previous Academic Year
3	Executive Committee in the current Academic Year
4	Project Director/Assistant Project Director for major projects in the current Academic Year
5 (Lowest)	Subcomm for any major project in the current Academic Year Subcomm for any major project in the previous Academic Year

\*Major Projects will include but not limited to: Annual Orientation Camp

\*\*Any other Major Projects will be determined by the current Executive Committee

\*\*\*The Executive Committee reserves the right to select Project Directors and Assistant Project Directors for any project under NUS Psychology Society.

The top 10 applicants will be eligible based on their priority level. In the event of a tie in priority, all tied applicants are expected to send a short write-up (no more than 300 words) justifying their suitability and reasons for wanting the scheme. A vote will be conducted within the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will then cast their (each person must vote and is allowed to vote for as many candidates as they want, including voting for themselves).

In the event of a tie, the President will determine the most suitable applicant.

#### *Scenario 2: Less than or equal to 10 applicants*

No other procedures are necessary. The President will facilitate the process.

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
